

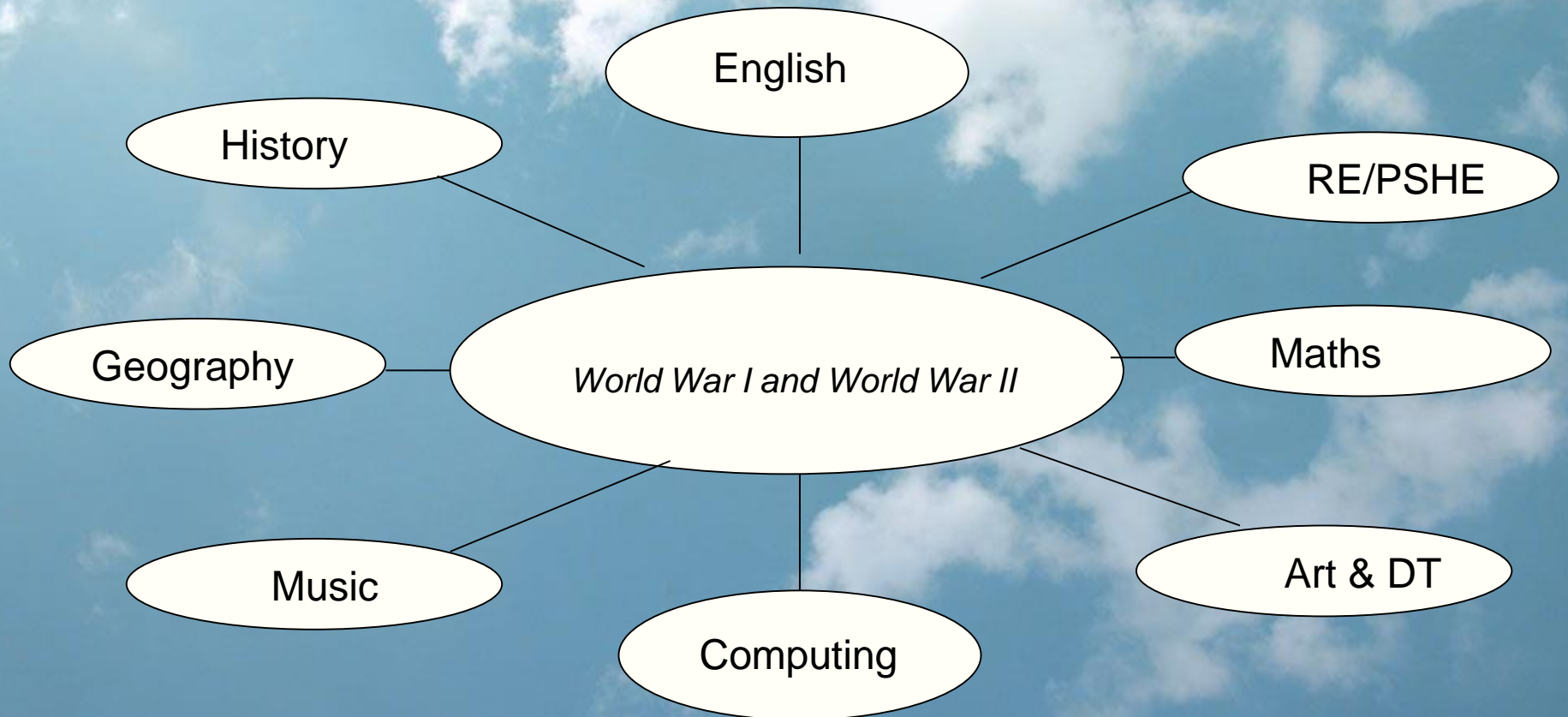

Skills and knowledge based Curriculum



Reading

- Each child has a reading record to be completed by themselves and/or an adult.
- *We encourage all children to write a comment to summarise the content of each read.*
- Expectations are that each child reads at least three times a week.

English

- English lessons are five times a week; reading and writing from a range of genres.
- A mixture of paired and independent work
- Spellings – twice a week.
- Grammar focus- three times a week.
- Spellings are given each week and will be tested every Friday.
- Lists of keywords will be sent home.

Maths

- 5 lessons per week.
- Expectations are that children practise tables at home and complete homework.
- Number focus this term with calculations and problem solving.

Homework

- Homework is sent out on Friday and is usually due in the following Wednesday.
- This will consist of a piece of English and Maths based task.
- Homework books.
- Children will receive extra play for completion of homework.
- Homework is an essential part of Year 6 and must be completed.

Physical Education

P.E is on Tuesdays during the Autumn term.

P.E Kit – colours of houses.

Indoor and outdoor kit with appropriate footwear – pumps/trainers.

Uniform

- Navy sweatshirt/cardigan, white/blue shirt/blouse, dark grey/black trousers or knee length skirt.
- Sensible black shoes. No Trainers.
